Otago and Beyond

Catlins, eastern coastal road. Catlins Information Centre, <u>www.catlins.org.nz</u> for further information on this scenic area.

Nugget Point Lighthouse, Kaka Point. Walk out to the lighthouse and view the dramatic coastline, seals and Celmisia lindsayii.

Curio Bay, New information centre and café. Walk along the beach and discover Gentianella saxosa and Myosotis rakiura growing in the sandbanks adjoining the grassed area. Also ancient petrified trees in the sea are visible at low tide.

Central Otago

Alexandra, interesting area, ancient goldmining sites. Major summer fruit growing area. Good accommodation and restaurants available along with excellent wines.



Old Man Range, accessible via Symes Road. Road can be very rough, more suitable for 4WD, probably not a hire car! Several gates, which must be left as found. Wonderful views from summit and wide range of plants to be found. Myosotis pulvinaris, Gentianella amabilis, Celmisia brevifolia. 4WD tours are available.

Pisa Range, excellent road access. Road toll applies, check in at hotel on the mountain where accommodation is also available. Excellent range of flora.

Queenstown, adventure playground of the south. Wide range of accommodation and restaurants for all tastes available.

The Remarkables Skifield, good access road, usually accessible with no gates. Leave vehicle in carpark and walk up to Lake Alta. Superb views. Rannunculus buchananii, Aciphylla simplex.

Wanaka, large grape growing region, wine tasting and excellent food. Many walks including Mt. Iron and Mt. Roy. Further information from the Wanaka Tourist Information Office www.lakewanaka.co.nz
